SUBJECT: 2017 DMV Grant Program Recommended Funding List

Honorable Board:

Pursuant to AB 2766, the Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District (District) receives "air quality impact" funds collected through the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) from each vehicle registered in District jurisdiction. The District primarily uses these funds to reduce mobile source (motor vehicle) emissions. AB 2766 funds are also used for public education, air monitoring, and technical studies/planning activities necessary for the California Clean Air Act.

A majority of AB 2766 funds are committed to eligible emission reduction projects through the District's DMV Grant Program. Approximately \$330,599 is required to fund all 2017 eligible projects. Eligible applicants were notified via mail that their projects will be recommended to your Board for funding. The nine projects include: One public EV charge station, one vanpool, one video conferencing system, and six road paving projects. The recommended project list is attached.

IT IS RECOMMENDED your Board receive and approve the District's 2017 DMV Grant Program Recommended project list; receive public comment; authorize Staff and Legal Counsel to draft necessary project implementation agreements; and bring back said agreements for consideration at the July 2017 Board meeting.
