ZEV REBATE PROGRAM GUIDELINES

I. AB 2766 Grant Funds Background

The Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District (District) receives AB 2766 funds through an "air quality impact" fee collected by the DMV. Revenues generated from AB 2766 are used to reduce air pollution generated from motor vehicles and their related activities.

The District allocates a substantial portion of its AB 2766 funds to the Zero Emissions Vehicle (ZEV) Rebate Program and DMV Grant Program. Both programs provide a mechanism for the fair, unbiased distribution of AB 2766 funds to eligible projects designed to reduce motor vehicle related emissions within Eastern Kern County.

This document is intended to provide guidance pertaining to the ZEV Rebate Program component of the District's AB 2766 grant programs. If you are interested in applying for an infrastructure, road paving, or public education grant, please see the DMV Grant Program Guidelines (Released October 1).

II. ZEV Rebate Program Overview

Eligible applicants will receive a Rebate of up to \$4,000, not exceeding 25% of total cost, for the **purchase** of a **new** ZEV with an EPA Smog Score of 10. All ZEV Rebate Program applications will be processed in the order they are received. ZEV Rebates are awarded first-come first-served until program funds have been exhausted.

III. Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Vehicle must be a ZEV, as defined by CARB LEV III with an EPA Smog Score of 10, and a new purchase from a dealership. *Leased or used vehicles are not eligible for rebate*.
- 2. A complete ZEV Rebate Program application package must be submitted within 30-days of purchase date of new eligible ZEV. A rebate will not be issued for a vehicle that was purchased greater than 30 days from application receipt date.
- 3. Applicant must primarily reside in Eastern Kern County and provide proof of residency. Proof of residency can include copy of driver's license or sales invoice for the new vehicle that lists an Eastern Kern address.
- 4. Applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
- 5. Applicant is only eligible to receive one ZEV Rebate per 12 months.
- 6. If the applicant is a business, school, non-profit organization, government agency, municipality, or entity, the physical address must be located within Eastern Kern County.

IV. How to Apply

- 1. Submit a complete ZEV Rebate Program application package within 30-days of purchasing a new eligible ZEV. Application receipt date will be the USPS postmark date on the envelope or District stamped hand delivery date.
- 2. A complete ZEV Rebate Program application package includes the following:
 - A. Completed District ZEV Rebate Program application that is signed and dated.
 - B. Copy of Applicant's sales invoice/contract for the new eligible ZEV.
 - C. Photocopy of Applicant's Driver's License.
 - D. Completed IRS Form W9 that is signed and dated.
- 3. Applicant's name and address must match on all required documents.

Note: If applicant recently moved and address listed on Driver's License is incorrect, address listed on new ZEV sales invoice will suffice.

District reserves the right to reject any or all applications.

A rebate will not be issued if the vehicle was purchased greater than 30-days from the postmark date or hand delivery date of the application package.

A rebate will not be issued if application package is incomplete.

All applications become property of the District.


All applications are subject to the public information act.

V. Payment

Grantee will be issued the rebate within 30 days of submitting a ZEV Rebate Program application package that the District has deemed to be complete and eligible for funding.
