Diesel-Fueled Swather

Honorable Board:

Rancho De Nada, LLC. (Grantee) has applied for funding through the Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District (District) Carl Moyer Program (CMP). The CMP provides funding for the voluntary retirement and replacement of eligible high-emitting diesel-fueled equipment.

The Grantee has proposed a project that meets eligibility criteria of the CMP. Agreement 05-003-2025 will provide up to \$166,724.00 in CMP funds to replace a 1988, diesel-fueled, Tier 0, New Holland Swather with a new low-emitting, certified Tier IV Swather. The equipment is used 100% of the time within Eastern Kern for farming activities.

The Grantee is responsible for any project costs exceeding the District maximum funding amount. The old swather will be permanently removed from service and salvaged once the new equipment has been purchased and placed in service. Staff recommends the project be approved for funding.

Three copies of the proposed agreement, a copy of which is attached, were sent to the Grantee to be approve by signature and are expected to be returned to the District prior to the Board Meeting. If any significant changes are identified by the Grantee, the item will be withdrawn and the Agreement will be held to the July 2025, Board Meeting.

IT IS RECOMMENDED your Board approve and authorize Chairman to sign Agreement 05-003-2025 with Rancho De Nada, LLC. for the purchase of a new low-emitting swather.
